
The Abbey at Westminster Plaza provides our residents with a greater opportunity for experiencing a healthier, happier and more distinctive lifestyle through active senior living.

The Vision of One Woman

It all began over a half century ago with one courageous woman, Mrs. Ottis Lake of Jacksonville, Texas. As a professional nurse, she dedicated her life to seeing that those needing nursing and assistance would receive the best care available. Mrs. Lake's commitment was premised on her belief that she had received a divine calling to build and provide a nursing care facility for seniors. Her dream encompassed everyone who needed care, regardless of the person's situation Mrs. Ottis Lake With the help of in life. a prominent Tyler oilman, Mr. J. Burns Brown and his wife, she opened her first very up-scale facility licensed for 54 beds.

She and a handful of very willing colleagues

successfully lobbied the State Legislature in Austin for minimum standards and licensing regulations. Her high expectations helped to establish an historic benchmark for care of the elderly. When Medicare began in 1966, her facility became one of the very first in the state to be certified for participation and the 30th facility licensed in the state of Texas.
